## WHAT IS THE PROGRAM STRUCTURE?

### Overall Program Orientation

This program enhances your subtype knowledge and skills in using this important aspect of the Enneagram in your work with clients. Each of the four in-person sessions are nine hours long. They begin at 8 am and end at 5 pm, with assignments given in-between.

#### Session 1 | Program overview

Session 1 sets the framework and content for the program, starting with why we are doing a subtype program and what makes the instinctual subtypes so important. To that end, we will create a common subtype language, illuminate the key elements or structure of what type really is, and then dive into the instincts, the nine passions, and subtype theory and practice.

If you teach subtypes too early, people get confused. If you don't know subtypes or don't use subtypes at all, you might unintentionally confuse or mislead people by giving examples of a type that goes with one subtype but leave out the other two subtypes. You might also unintentionally mistype people by not being knowledgeable about the subtypes because some subtypes may look more like another type than the actual type of the person.

### Session 2 | Typing and teaching subtypes

How do you use subtype information when working to help others find their type accurately? How much or how little do you teach and when? How much do you need to know in order to teach subtypes as they relate to specific applications? How do you teach subtypes so you don't have to have all the answers, but allow those you teach to get enough information from you to identify their subtypes themselves. You'll receive great PowerPoint slides and practice your teaching skills with real-time feedback.

## Session 3 | Deeper work with subtypes and instincts

Because our subtype responses reflect when we function at our most automatic – meaning almost no room to push the pause button – working with subtype development can be a profound path to change and transformation. This session explores using subtypes for personal development and deep transformational work; learning and practicing subtype-based catalytic conversions; freeing our instincts – self-preserving, social and 1-1 – from our passions as a way to get our real needs met, and more.

### Session 4 | Subtype applications

This session focuses on understanding and exploring the major applications of using subtypes in a variety of teaching settings: relationships, conflict, leadership, teams and more. Subtype applications are rich in insight and practical in application.

### Clearing up confusions

What are the best names to use for instincts? What words do we use for the nine emotional habits ("passions")? What are the best names to use for each of the subtypes?

How can you remember all you need to know about the 27 different subtypes? What is most important to know? How do you learn more? We'll address all these questions.
